The horn and piano play as one in Lorie

The Austrian duo gave a heartfelt performance from the Château's grand gallery.

They travelled from Vienna to give concerts in France over a period of a few days. On Saturday evening they played on the grand gallery of the Château de la Lorie before an audience of 90.

The Austrian duo, Johanna Horny-Neumann on the piano and Roland Horvath gave a 2-hour concert of music by Beethoven, Mozart and Schubert. The synergy between the two musicians was incredible and the enthusiastic historical narration given by the Viennese horn player between each piece only added a touch of eloquence to the performance. "Our duo has a certain amount of unity", says Roland Horvath. "It's a long story, involving the horn and the heart".

These types of concerts will be an ongoing feature at the Château de La Lorie. Madame de Saint-Genys is not reticent. "We may host other performances, particularly of choral works, which I love".

The Château de la Lorie will be open on the 20th and 21st of September for heritage days.
